Article 1. Purposes & Scopes of cooperation


- 1-1 Joint educational and research activities

- 1-9 Mutual collaboration in the field of commercialization of knowledge
- 1-10To study the feasibility for setting up IAU new branch with collaboration of partner university
- 1-11 To disseminate both countries language and literature

Article 2 Obligations

- 2.1 The parties recognize that the implementation of any agreed upon activities will depended on the interests and expertise of the individuals involved and the availability of financial resources, space and other facilities.
- 2.2 The parties understand that this MOU creater no financial and legal commitments for either party.
- 2.3 prior to implementing any of provisions of the MOU .it is necessary to regulate and sign a separate a contract which will be approved by the authorities of the both universities .
- 2.4 Neither party may assign or otherwise transfer any of its rights or obligations under this MOU, in whole or in part, to a third party.
- 2.5 The parties undertake that any information obtained from the other party is considered as confidential and is not achievable for the other directly or indirectly .2.6In case of mutual researches or programs leads to a new technological knowledge, an outcome or invention results are calculated with respect to the contribution of each of the parties. Partner,s share will be calculated based on unique contracts signed by the two parties for performing the goals of this memorandum.

- 3.1 This MOU WILL BE VALID FROM 1398/2/10 TILL 1403/2/10 Solar calendar equal to 30/APRIL 2019 Till 30/ APRIL 2024 AD. FOR 5 Years.
- 3.2 The parties agree to periodically review the activities undertaken. And the progress made, and consult concerning amendments. Renewal or termination of this MOU .The MOU can be modified upon mutual written consent.
- 3.3 Any revision or termination of this agreement shall not undermine the validity or implementation of separately concleded agreements.
- 3.4 The MOU could be extended upon the request of one party in writing three months prior to the termination of the initial period, and the termination of this agreement shall not undermine the implementation of current obligations of both sides.
- 3.5 This MOU consisting of three articles, is prepared in English in two original copies m both copies being considered of identical legal validity. Any discrepancy/ies in interpretation of this MOU shall be settled through negotiations between both parties, working groups. if negotiations fail to success the matters will be referred to an impartial legal consultant or jury.
